



The submitted manuscript must be formatted according to the instructions, otherwise the manuscript will be sent back to the author for correction.

### *Title Page*

The title page should include:

- The name(s) of the author(s)
- A concise and informative title
- The affiliation(s) and address(es) of the author(s)
- The e-mail address, and telephone number(s) of the corresponding author
- If available, the 16-digit ORCID of the author(s)

### *Abstract*

Please provide an abstract of 250 words. The abstract should not contain any undefined abbreviations or unspecified references.

### *Keywords*

Please provide 4 to 6 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.

### *Text Formatting*

Manuscripts should be submitted in Word.

- The text of a research paper should be divided into Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgements, Conflict of Interest, and References.

### *Figures*

Either incorporate the figures into the text or indicate their place in the text. Figures should be clear and the lettering legible and proportional to the size of the figure so that reduction is possible if necessary. Figures will appear in color online and in the final PDF. Please submit all figures in high resolution and without frames around them. Figures, photos, illustrations, schemes and graphs should be referred to in the text as figures and numbered consecutively throughout the paper by Arabic numerals.

### *References*

References must be identified by Arabic numerals (e.g. 1, 2 etc.), numbered consecutively in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text (between square brackets) and listed at the end of paper.

Author(s) Last Name /Family/Surname, Initials.,. Title of article. Title of journal (Abbreviated), Volume number (Issue number, if any): Publication year, page numbers of the article.

**Tables:** Cite tables in numerical order in the text using Arabic numbers. The table headings should be as follows: Table 1, 2, 3. Each table should have a descriptive title.

**List of symbols:** A list of symbols is required if equations are used.
